Thank you for your interest in the Durham Warm Water Aquatic Program, an arthritis friendly program. In order to attend participants must be independently mobile and do not require assistance.

Classes are held at Grandview Children's Centre, 600 Townline Rd S, Oshawa, ON L1H 7K6 (located on the corner of Townline and Bloor St. in Oshawa). Classes are conducted by trained volunteers and given in therapeutic water temperature. Fees are very reasonable and do not, therefore allow for any make- up classes or any refunds to be given for classes missed by a participant, or if classes are cancelled due to pool malfunction, bad weather, or other situations beyond our control. If a holiday falls during the session or you join a class after the session has started, the cost will be pro-rated.

Each session runs for 10 weeks at a cost of \$60.

Once you are in the program you can register for as many subsequent sessions as you wish if spaces are available. You may also attend more that once a week, space permitting.
